



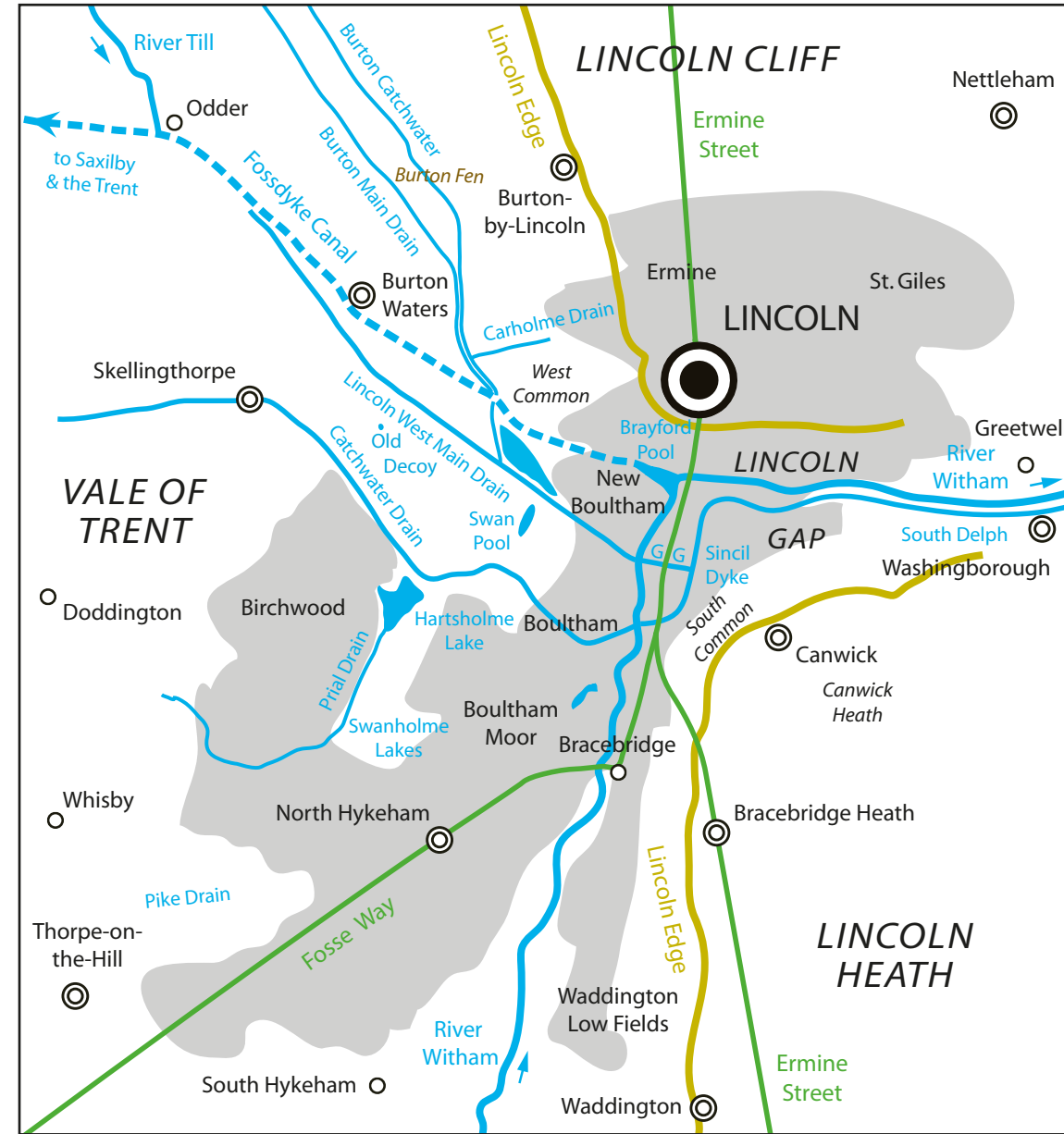
### MAP FOR CHAPTER V :
